

4. CAMPING GEAR - GROUP

GROUP PACK 1
CANOE PACK, 100-115 LITRES
First Aid Kit must be readily accessible near top of pack

SHELTER EQUIPMENT

tent (1)	tarp ground sheet (1) - goes underneath tent	extra pegs
vestibule (optional)		gear loft
tent repair kit (duct tape)	tent lantern (1) - personal flashlight can double as lantern	
FOR GROUP OF 3 or More		
tents (divide group size by 2 & roundup = max # of tents)		# of tarps (matches # of tents)

NOTES ON SHELTER EQUIPMENT

Ensure waterproofness	seal seams in fly	repair any holes
Check zippers	Check poles for nicks & cracks	

CAMP GEAR & TOOLS

Axe or hatchet	Shovel, folding	Saw, folding
Brush or wisk	Pulleys & Biners	Rope

NAVIGATION

Topographical Maps	Compass (spare)
OPT: GPS	OPT: star charts

FIRST AID & EMERGENCY

FIRST AID

First Aid Kit (1)	Emergency blanket (1)	Snake Bite Kit (1)
Sunblock or Sunscreen	Calomine (1)	Bug spray

EMERGENCY SHELTER (can double as a Kitchener Shelter)

Tarp, Orange (at least 6' x 7', light weight, waterproof) with adequate tie-lines

CAMPFIRE

See Personal Pack

MATCHES, in waterproof container	LIGHTER, WATERPROOF	FLINT & STRIKER
Battery, AA or 9V (Optional)		

Some of this material can be gathered at the Campsite, while others can be collected and packed in.

TINDER - STARTER MATERIAL

Steel wool	Candle	dried moss
bark, shredded (birch or cedar)	lint	feather down
cat tail wool	milkweed "feathers"	dry leaves

newspaper (for car camping basecamp)

Obtained At The Campsite (either purchased from campgrounds or scavenged from "deadfall")

KINDLING

- tiny twigs (no larger than a toothpick)
- small twigs (no larger than a chop stick in diameter)
- small branches (no larger than your thumb in diameter)

FIREWOOD

small to medium logs cut into lengths no longer than 12-16 inches
